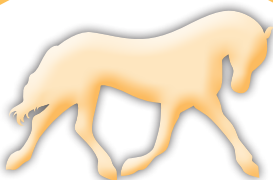

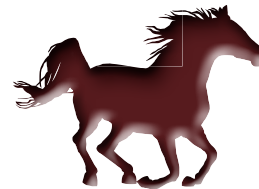

What I Learned at the Schleese Custom Saddle Fitting

Jochen Schleese, certified master saddler and saddle ergonomist, recently visited farms in our area to do perform custom saddle fittings for his own line of saddles: Schleese Saddlery.

Mr. Schleese has been a regular contributor to *Elite Equestrian* magazine for several years now, and I have become quite a fan of his. I truly enjoy every article he has written for us, and I also read his recent book "Suffering in Silence". I believe he has an excellent foundation for his theories, which are spelled out in his book. I also think he explains his findings on the structure of the horse with functions of the saddle fit, and the results, in a very easily understandable manner that makes perfect sense. So when he was in my area, I made it a point to meet him and sit in on a few saddle fittings.

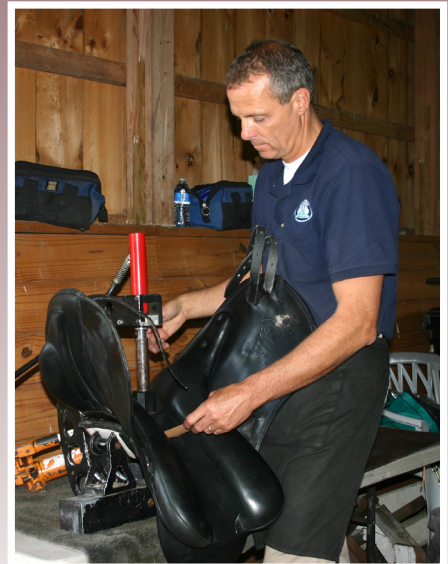
When I arrived, ESDCTA Newsletter Editor, Meredith Rogers, was having a session.


Mr. Schleese had each of the riders perform walk-trot-canter both ways so he could observe the rider on the horse. He explained what he was noticing to me, and how the saddle fit was affecting the horse's movements. He then carefully measured the animal and checked the wear patterns on the back from the saddle. After changing to a better fitting saddle, all the horses had noticeably smoother gaits and better movement that the riders also remarked on. It was amazing!

Meredith echoed this in her experience: "You never know how uncomfortable your saddle is until after a proper saddle fitting and your horse tells you it fits better by going better."

SO WHERE ARE YOU NOW?

Summer is here. Hopefully, you've had the chance to get out and do a bit of competing this year. You've probably had some successes and some challenges. Your success may have come in the form of finally presenting a decent dressage movement, rather than winning your division. Your challenge may not have shown in your score, but you know it didn't go very well. You got your horse to jump the ditch without penalty, but it was sticky. You wonder if he'll ever fly over the hole in the ground without acting like a monster is going to reach up and bite his belly.

You may have started your season with very set goals in mind. Did you put pressure on yourself to be fully proficient at some element or level by this point? Did you boast to your friends or trainer that this was going to be your year to excel, no matter what? If you've met your goals, great. If not, congratulations, you're human, partnered with a beast possessing his own mind and body. For professionals, delays in meeting goals can have significant financial impact. For the majority of eventers, however, this is not the case. Riders are amateurs and the sport is supposed to be fun. Modifying goals is part of good horsemanship. Inflexibility can be counterproductive.

So here we are at midseason. It's a natural time to reflect on what has been accomplished and what plans should be made. We identified a few associated questions and asked for feedback from individuals with a variety of experience. (See below for information about those who contributed answers to these questions. ESDCTA is very grateful for their time and willingness to help.)

How do you know when it's time for you or a student to move up a level?

Several of the answers centered on the rider's mindset. A few suggested that the rider should be relatively bored with their current level. There's a good bit of sense to this. You and your horse are going to have a maximum attainable level, which is probably not 4 star. Why rush to move up a few levels just to get stuck there with no opportunity to move further? Enjoy your rides. Each good outing builds confidence for you and your horse. Each higher level has a faster pace. While trying to avoid speed faults, you could begin learning the pace of that next level. Learn how to use your watch.

One ESDCTA member was very successful at her current

level. Her ultimate goal was to master a level very similar to what she was doing. In order to avoid maxing out too soon, she made a point of participating at venues where she had never previously competed. If all of your events for the given level have been at one or two locations, your experience is limited. You and your horse need experience with different looking fences over varied terrain.

Of course, you shouldn't move up a level until you have been consistently schooling at the next level. A starter horse shouldn't be asked to canter his first 20-meter circle in a dressage ring if he's been learning to canter in a much bigger area at home. You shouldn't sign up for a training level event if you haven't schooled training level cross-country fences. Successfully jumping that height in a ring in no way guarantees that cross-country fences at that height will not present problems. Riders need to take advantage of cross-country schooling opportunities as they present. Goal setting should include firm plans to get to the cross-country schooling days. Which fences to be practiced can be decided upon that day or nearer the time.

If your jumping is solid for the level, but your dressage is not, is it okay to move up?

On quick glance, it appears that the answers were split right down the middle. There was a common thread; however, throughout the replies. Dressage is the basis. If you're consistently within a few points of the leaders of the division, this may just be a reflection of your dressage being a work in progress. If your horse is obedient, but showing a mild bit of tension, he may just need more confidence building outings. If your partner is not the best mover, he may never win his class. Keep in mind, that gaits are only a small part of the overall score. If you are consistently out of range with the top of the group, you really need to read your tests and work with your trainer to determine why. It's one thing if you regularly lose points because your horse hasn't figured out how to stretch at the stretchy trot. It's quite another thing if the horse submission or rider effectiveness scores are poor. If this is problematic on the flat, how can you be safe over fences?

You also need to determine what's important to you. Most lower-level events are won on the dressage score. If you

can't take the thought of being out of the ribbons, then don't move up yet. In the meantime, you may want to practice the next level tests at a dressage schooling show to see where your weaknesses might be and know what you need to work on.

Is competing at jumper or dressage shows, in addition to events, significantly beneficial to improving your score at an event?

The recurrent answer to this question was "absolutely." This will help build mileage and confidence. Without the pressure to run off to ride other phases, an eventer can watch the performances of those who show dressage or jumpers exclusively. This may help the eventer see what it takes to put in a truly good performance. These shows may also be easier on the bank account than a full event.

It's important that these shows don't become your horse's second active career. He shouldn't be eventing every few weeks and showing every weekend in between. Again, this is where planning really matters. Look at the omnibus and determine what a reasonable schedule is for you and your horse. It's tempting to go to a jumper show just because the weather's nice and you have no other plans. If you're not considering what events he's also doing, you may be throwing too much at him.

The hardest move up is from what level to what level? (excluding Intermediate/Advanced and professionals).

The move from training level to preliminary level won this category hands down. USEA statistics show that most

amateurs are riding at training level or below. Preliminary has speed and technical questions that require a significant commitment to fitness and education from experienced coaches. Many riders don't make such a commitment.

The move from novice to training was considered to be more challenging than from beginner novice to novice.

Is it ever okay for an inexperienced horse and rider to learn to event as a team or must one of them be experienced?

This may sometimes be okay, but never without an experienced eventing trainer. The time to advance will take significantly longer. Rushing up the levels will greatly increase the likelihood of a seriously bad outcome. Learning will be easier if the horse or rider is at least experienced in another specialty, like hunters. A green rider partnered with a young OTTB trying to learn eventing together is not a good idea.

There are plenty of opportunities to gain experience that transfer well to an event. An event shouldn't be a green team's first outing. Go to several dressage and jumper shows prior to entering an event. Many events have one or two levels below beginner novice. Take advantage of these levels. Hacking or hunter pacing with an experienced, well-behaved partner is fabulous for building horse and rider confidence.

HEADS UP COMPETITORS IN THE SUMMER DAYS SHOWS ON JULY 30 & 31

The USET Headquarters will be enforcing the BioSecurity Guidelines developed in 2013. These guidelines include a 48-hour vet certificate declaring that your horse is in good health.

This veterinary certificate must be submitted to the entry secretary when you check in at the show.

The following is a copy of their biosecurity policy as well as a sample form for your veterinarian to complete.

USET FOUNDATION NEWS

Updated biosecurity protocols for USET Foundation

By USEF - ALL DISCIPLINE - Posted April 3, 2013

GLADSTONE, NJ, April 1, 2013- In light of the recent EHV-1 (equine herpes virus) outbreak the USET Foundation has announced updated biosecurity protocols for all horses entering the USET Foundation Hamilton Farm Facility. This protocol has been put in place under the advisement of our USET veterinarians to ensure the health and safety of all horses entering the facility as we strive to keep our environment available, safe and healthy for upcoming equestrian events.

Updated biosecurity protocols for USET Foundation include:

A current negative coggins test. It is strongly recommended that all horses be vaccinated for Equine EHV-1 (either modified live or killed vaccine) no sooner than 7 days prior and no later than 90 days prior to entering the USET Foundation. Most EHV-1 vaccines are only considered effective for 90 days. Check with your veterinarian about which vaccine you should use.

Any horses shipping into the USET Foundation will require a 48-hour health certificate or statement on official licensed veterinarian letterhead. All horses should be able to provide proof of vaccine, preferably labeled on the health certificate.

Document your horses normal temperature prior to arrival. PLEASE DO NOT SHIP HORSES WITH ELEVATED TEMPERATURES since this is usually an early and effective indicator of a problem.

The attached form will be required for all horses entering the facility. This form is to certify that none of the horses in your care have been in direct contact or stabled with any horses that have received a positive test for the EHV-1 virus or have been stabled at a quarantined facility. By signing this form you certify that you will continue to follow all biosecurity precautions set forth by the USET Foundation.

At this time we will not be requiring temperature checks by on-site veterinarians upon arrival, however, again we urge you to practice routine temperature checks on your horses daily.

"We would like to thank everyone for their diligence in adhering to this important protocol so we can continue to make our facility available and keep your horses healthy", said Executive Director, Bonnie Jenkins.

The Dressage Competitions Committee is looking for members to expand the committee. 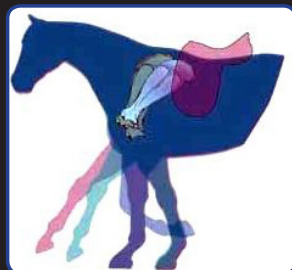

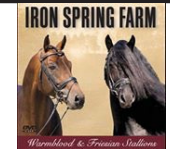

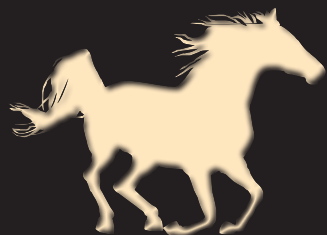
