



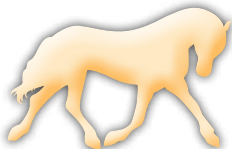

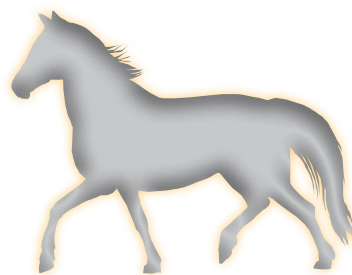

“THINKING FASTER WITH ERIC SMILEY”

First off, it was hot and rainy! However as Beth Sokohl, the clinic organizer said, “We eventers really know how to make lemons into lemonade!” Inspired by our gorgeous surroundings, three days away from our “real” jobs and the contagious energy and enthusiasm of Eric Smiley, our one day of indoor riding that turned into three did not disappoint! On the first three days of July, the two of us, Carey Williams and Hillary Horton, traveled to Sunset Hill Farm in Woodbine, MD, for three days of instruction with Ireland’s great Eric Smiley, four-time Eventing Olympian, who now resides on the south coast of England.

Carey’s horse Skip, a 7 year old OTTB, who ended his successful racing career at 5 years old with a bowed tendon, has been with Carey for almost 2 years and has been competing in eventing for about 8 months, taking at least second place at pretty much every event he has been to. As Carey put it, “He has a great mind which is why we get along so well; however, I have never come across such a lazy racehorse! Which is why I went to the Eric Smiley Clinic, hoping he could help me find some way to wake him up!” And wake him up we did. Hillary and her new mare Bailey, a 5-year-old Buckskin TB (yes, that is a Jockey Club registered Buckskin!), have been together for just 4 months and are still in the getting to know each other phase of their partnership.

Day 1 was dressage day where it was very appropriate that Skip and Bailey were paired together due to the fact that they both needed a little bit of ‘sparkle’ added to their step. Eric first demonstrated how to make the horse listen to the ‘correct amount of leg’ by using the dressage whip effectively and making it ‘hiss,’ which got an immediate response from both horses. Once the horses were responding to a light leg we worked on quick transitions to engage their hind legs even more. After they had their feet moving, lateral work was introduced. Eric suggested “walking” turns on the forehand to keep their hind end stepping around. These were eventually

followed by moving out of the turn into trot. Both pairs felt the real power of the hind end pushing them into the trot instead of the usual sluggish upward transition. After improving the quality of the upwards transitions, Eric moved on to instructing both girls on how to improve the promptness and smoothness of the downward transitions, using the horses’ natural anticipation to develop the canter-to-halt transition – surprising the riders that their horses were so balanced!

Day 2 was stadium jumping exercises which were brought inside due to the inclement weather. The theme of this day was “the LINE is PRIMARY”. Skip and Bailey were not paired together but all of the groups focused on finding the “correct canter,” keeping it over a pole on the ground and then riding positively forward on lines and courses without chasing to the jump. No matter what the line or how many strides you got, the correct way to ride was to keep the canter consistent and not let them get too slow or too fast before and after fences. Riders did this by looking toward each fence and NOT focusing on making corners too deep where the horse might drift past the line or add needless seconds to the round. This was difficult for those of us who have been taught for years to go into our corners, but each of us could see where this would be a very useful skill for the course walking tool kit. The higher level groups practiced exercises to help with adjustability, such as jumping a five-stride line with four or six strides, while the greener groups worked on developing the horses’ initiative to take the ride to the fence.

On Day 3 we all woke up a bit of disappointed when we looked outside to find it pouring rain, again. However, we all knew the smart decision was to move cross-country day indoors. Luckily, Eric had a bunch of tricks up his sleeves and did not disappoint! With bounces, coops, triple bars, corners,



liverpools and skinnies (oh my!) made with stadium jumps and other strange items (like mounting blocks!) we had a productive session teaching the horses to think quickly and look for their next fence. Tight turns were a recurring theme for all of the groups (except the real greenies). Eric emphasized trusting the horse to “make a decision” about the distance while the rider focused on line and speed control – faster for some and less for others. Staying on the line gave green horses confidence and permitted them to assess each new jump (some of them built to look very odd). One thing we both admired about Eric was his emphasis, especially with the greener horses, on giving them permission to look and assess the situation as long as they were still moving forward to the jump. Skip’s technique improved remarkably as he learned to coil his energy on the turn and use power from the hind end to jump with impulsion. For Bailey, a talented but naturally cautious mare, confidence was the name of the game as Eric patiently taught her to tackle her first liverpool, chevron, corner, and bounce. Remembering what our job is – setting up the horse to make the right decision and allowing him to jump without interference – was critical as this day’s lesson went on, and the turns got tighter, and the jumps got more and more difficult. Both horses grew up A LOT and seemed very proud of themselves!

It was simply wonderful to spend three days riding and observing – having a chance to see Eric, one of the true masters of eventing, improve pair after pair was inspiring and humbling. As an added bonus, we feel much more prepared for Bailey’s first event and Skip’s move-up to recognized Novice at the end of July.

Eligibility Rule and Qualifying Criteria:

The Dressage Championships are open to ESDCTA members who have earned a qualifying score during the qualifying period of August 21, 2012 to August 19, 2013. Membership in ESDCTA is required at the time the score is earned and said members must be "in good standing" when these qualifying scores are earned in order for them to count as qualifying scores. Any member not "in good standing" will not be eligible to ride in the championship show.

AWARDS: Mandatory mounted awards ceremony for championship classes.

Championship classes: Trophy/Prize for 1st place, Ribbons 1st thru 6th place.

ENTRIES: Please use 2013 ESDCTA schooling show entry form available in your Omnibus or on the ESDCTA website: www.esdcta.org. Proof of negative Coggins within 12 months must accompany entry. **Competitors in the dressage championships cannot also enter the Eventing Championships.**

Championship Classes will be divided Jr/YR and Senior as entries warrant. Please indicate Jr/YR or Senior on your entry form.

Note on scheduling: Time interval between rides: *DR 126.1 (b,5)* "In order to facilitate show scheduling considerations, management reserves the right to shorten the time interval between competitor rides for those competitors entering multiple classes or riding multiple horses".

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date less \$12 office fee. If rides are scratched after closing, refunds will be given minus the office fee to competitors whose ride times can be filled from the wait list. Stabling fees will be refunded if the stall can be re-rented. No refunds for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or the competition.

TIMES: Available by Wednesday, Sept. 11th, on web: www.esdcta.org, or by phone @ 610-868-3615 before 9 pm.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Classes will be run in accordance with USEF Championship rules:

Tests must be ridden from memory. No whips are allowed.

Exceptions: The arena fence at A may be left open. Centerline will not be marked.

OTHER: a) Intro and Training Level classes may be in a small arena. b) All dogs **MUST** be on a leash at all times. c) **Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel any class.**

FOOTING: Primarily sand with stone dust additive- all outdoor rings. Soil Composite - Indoor arena

DIRECTIONS:

From NJ Turnpike and I-195 East: Take Exit 7A to Route 195E to Exit 11. Make left to Route 524, then make right. Horse Park is on left, approximately 1 1/2 miles.

From the Garden State Parkway: Take Exit 98 to Route 195 West to Exit 11. Make a right to Route 524, then make a right. Horse Park is on left, approximately 1 1/2 miles.

From Route 537W (from Freehold, NJ): Route 537W to Route 524; Horse Park will be on right (about 15 minutes from the center of Freehold).

2013 ESDCTA DRESSAGE & EVENTING CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

I know the ESDCTA Championship Show is a long way off but now is the time to start thinking about qualifying. There is still plenty of time to earn your qualifying scores. So, stay as cool as you can, ride well, and see you in September. Look for the qualifier list on the ESDCTA website, www.esdcta.org in the next couple of weeks. Complete show information is in the Omnibus.

GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION:

SHOW DATE: September 15, 2013

LOCATION: Horse Park of New Jersey, Allentown, NJ

ENTRIES: Opening Date: July 27, 2013. Closing Date: August 19, 2013

MISCELLANEOUS: Must have been an ESDCTA member to qualify and a current member to participate in the show. Qualifying horse and rider pair must compete - no substitutions. Qualifying is based on rider, not horse. Riders cannot compete in both Dressage and Eventing classes. Riders can compete in only one level. Dressage Starter Riders - if you qualified as a Starter Rider but rode over Training 1 during the year, you cannot compete as a Starter Rider - Refer to Page 41 in the Omnibus under Year-End Award Information for complete Starter Rider definition.

DRESSAGE: QUALIFYING PERIOD: August 21, 2012 – August 19, 2013.

INFORMATION: SHOW RULES: Omnibus Page 22; **PRIZE LIST:** Omnibus Pages 131-132

QUALIFYING: One score earned at an ESDCTA-sanctioned schooling or recognized show published in the Omnibus or advertised in the ESDCTA newsletter as follows:

- **Starter - W/T** (USDF-A or USDF-B) or Starter – W/T/C (USDF-C or Training - 1): 60% or above
 - **Training - Second Levels** (Test 2 or 3): 60% or above
 - **Third - Fourth Levels** (Test 2 or 3) and FEI Levels: 58% or above
 - **Musical Freestyle:** USDF - 60% or above. FEI - 58% or above
 - **Dressage Seat Equitation:** For USDF - C and above - Automatic through your one qualifying score or by riding in a DSE class and obtaining a minimum score of 68%

Overall, it was definitely a fantastic weekend. I am so glad I have had the opportunity to attend the festival for the past couple of years. I would not hesitate to apply for the ESDCTA team again, and encourage any other youth members to do so as well. This is not only a great educational opportunity and a fun competition, but an amazing opportunity to experience the fun and camaraderie of making new friends and competing as a team. It's definitely an experience not to be missed!

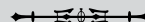
