## Jersey Fresh International Three-Day Event – Truly an Event That Was Not to Be Missed!

They came, danced, ran, and jumped. The Horse Park of New Jersey hosted the Jersey Fresh Three Day Event May 9-12. With levels that included CIC3\*, CIC2\*, CCI3\* and CCI2\*, some of the best equine and human talent from within and beyond US borders graced New Jersey with generous displays of athleticism and sportsmanship. Tailgaters at the water complex had an incredibly close view to the action and partied with friends between rider trips. The picture to the right taken by the Jersey Shore Area Steward, Dr. Carey Williams, shows the tailgaters taking a dip in the water complex during one of the intermissions. Mother Nature cooperated by providing clouds to keep the horses cooler but holding off a thunderstorm until just after competition had concluded on Saturday, cross country day.

In the end, the big CIC3\* division wrapped up on Sunday with an extremely exciting finish. Jessica Phoenix on Exponential was sitting in second place with Buck Davidson riding D.A. Adirmo (the picture to the right, Buck on XC coming out of the water complex during the CCI3\* division, photo C. Williams) in first with only 1 rail to spare. Unfortunately a second rail came down for Buck switching the lead and giving first place to Jessica. The other divisions finished with Caitlin Silliman on Remington XXV taking first in the CCI2\* division and Will Faudree riding Riesling De Buissy in second. The CIC3\* division was Will Faudree again, this time riding Andromaque and Jennie Brannigan Cambalda in second. And finally the CIC2\* division wrapped up with Lauren Kieffer riding Veronica in first and Sharon White riding Don Sheffield in second. ESDCTA members made up much of the volunteer labor pool. Without volunteers, such an event could not have taken place. Kathy Swangler, a lower level eventer, and her non

horsey husband Gary, returned for another year as country fence judges. Kathy continued to remark about how well the volunteers have been treated by organizers, officials, and riders through the years. Youth riders, Erika, Jorgen and Mia Olijslager were stationed as fence judges at a combination that saw more than one fall. In addition to recording the rounds, Jorgen provided valuable support to the officials by answering several questions about the falls he had witnessed. This information is an important component of the safety reviews in place at recognized events.

While most volunteers are available for a day or two, one young ESDCTA member had opportunity for extended service at the event. Christy Pellegrino was able to volunteer Monday through Sunday as a school-sanctioned activity and was able to help with a variety of activities. She found working with course designer, Jeanine, particularly fascinating. Course design is much more complicated than scattering brush and flowers around a jump. Thorough consideration must be given to the horse's vision and the path over which the rider will be piloting him. Christy also found the jog (horse inspections) very interesting. Some of the horses clearly were very businesslike. Others were overly exuberant. Unfortunately, some of the horse were not accepted and were not allowed to compete. Christy was impressed by the reaction of the riders to the bad news. While clearly disappointed at not being able to go on, the riders were gracious and demonstrated their commitment to their partners' well being.

Overall this even was said by many to be the best Jersey Fresh yet. We all look forward to next year when Jersey Fresh will run its 12th International Three-Day Event. #### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I am coming off the breeding season both for my mare and my collie dogs. I wonder why I do this.

First, just deciding on the stud can be a roller coaster, but it is always fun. In the dog world, everyone is selling their own puppies, so it is hard to get a good and fair opinion when you haven't been in the business for 30 years. If you have a dog with the same lines as someone else, keep an eye out for who they are breeding to! On the horse side, everyone has likes and dislikes. You need to decide on what you are breeding for: gait, conformation, height, disposition, color, or (of course) a champion. Go to Chronicle of the Horse, Facebook, and other websites. You can get lots of information and opinions, but remember, none are specific to the combination of a particular stallion with your mare.

So what about genetics? Does your mare throw more of her own characteristics, or does the stud have the dominant influence on the outcome? Unfortunately, this takes repetitive breedings to figure out.

Bottom line... it's a crap shoot. Which is why my dear husband, Howard, just loves to breed. ONLY KIDDING! It's just another horsey money pit to him.

Seriously, you can do a lot of research, speak to qualified breeders, and come up with decent odds. Or, you can have a stallion party with your girlfriends, ooh and ahhh over the videos while drinking martinis, and just have a good time not thinking about the HUGE investment.

Be very careful about your motives. Is your intention to sell the progeny of the animal you think is so great you just have to breed it? Or is it to keep another like your beloved? Are you aware of the costs and the risks? Not all breedings take, not all takes result in live foals.

Years ago, I bred Appaloosas. Not only was that a wait for the foal to drop, it was a wait for color when that foal appeared. Despite Howard's usually curmudgeonous attitude toward the time and money, he got so attached to one of the foals that it nearly broke his heart when the colt was shipped off to Colorado to his new owner.

If you are in the midst of planning a breeding and never have before, take heart. There is nothing like the birth of your new investment. It never loses its magic.

Whatever all of you breeders out there were blessed with this spring, I wish you all the best! May that foal fulfill your dream.



The Horse Park of New Jersey in Allentown, NJ, is an important contributor to the success of ESDCTA, with several shows and events happening there, as well as other horserelated activities.

Encompassing 170+ acres, the Horse Park is a premier venue for equine events, but it wasn't always that way. Back in the late 1970s, a group of determined horse enthusiasts were witnessing the rapid loss of horse-friendly land and wanted to do something about it. Led by Stanley Klos, a historian, author, entrepreneur, and former Italian basketball player, and Tony Nini, the former President of the Thoroughbred Breeders' Association of New Jersey, the High Meadow Orchard Associates (HMOA) originally obtained the land to create a Thoroughbred equestrian community. The HPNJ opened in 1983 through a unique collaboration between public, notfor-profit, and private entities. In 1989, the NJ Department of Environmental Protection purchased the land from the HMOA with Green Acres Funds. It is currently operated under contract with the Department of Agriculture and the Horse Park of New Jersey, Stone Tavern, Inc., a not-for-profit educational organization. However, the HPNJ would not be the world-class destination it is without the help of the dedicated volunteers who perform a range of tasks to keep the park going, from painting stalls to maintaining flowerbeds to cleaning up the grounds to hosting fundraisers. ## \*\*Please Note there are new health requirements for your horse to attend the Fix-a-Test Clinics\*\*

All horses are required to have a current Coggins Certificate (within last 12 months) and be vaccinated for Equine EHV-1 (either modified live or killed vaccine) no sooner than 7 days prior and no later than 90 days prior to the event. Please contact the event organizers for any additional health requirements that may be necessary such as documentation of a temperature chart or health certificate. PLEASE DO NOT SHIP HORSES WITH ELEVATED TEMPERATURES since this is usually an early and effective indicator of a problem.

#### FOALIN' AROUND Youth News, Activities, and Opportunities

#### Youth Fix-A-Test Clinic By Jessica Kuc

On May 4, a Youth Fix-A-Test Clinic was held with clinician Ann Forer, an "R" dressage judge. Nine participants, including six youth members, two adult amateurs, and one open rider, rode in the clinic at Hidden Creek Equestrian Center in Kunkletown, Pennsylvania.

While the clinic was marketed as a fix-a-test, many riders chose to ride a test once and spend the rest of the allotted time in a lesson with Ann. A few did pick to ride their test a second time at the end of the lesson, and each of these riders saw their scores improve – some as much as seven percentage points. Everyone left the clinic with valuable tips and insight.

Ann seemed to focus on the big picture with each rider. She commented on each rider's position, effectiveness of the aids, and harmony with the horse. She had great ideas of how to help the horses as well, including improving connection and freedom through their backs.

Horse and rider pairs ranged from Starter Walk/Trot to First Level, and even included some eventing tests. Some participants rode lesson horses while some rode their own. The clinic's youngest participant was seven-year-old Allison Roecker, who wanted feedback on her dressage tests on her new horse, Nora. Ann helped Allison improve her position to increase her control and harmony with her speedy little horse! Similar tips helped Abigail Knudsen, another youth member who has only been riding Haflinger gelding, Mawby, for a few months. Mawby came in the ring with extra energy, and Ann helped Abigail channel the energy for good, diverting Mawby from playful behavior.

Other riders needed help as they made the jump from Training to First Level. Ann helped youth member Holly Ahner prepare for each of the movements in her test and push Duncan, an off-the-track Thoroughbred, forward over his back to a soft contact. Ann helped Becky Kuc to build a steady connection with her young horse, Harley, for a more fluid First Level test.

Ann's expertise was not confined to the ring. She sat down with the participants and auditors over lunch to discuss how judges arrive at a score and what some of her show ring pet peeves are. She asked participants to share their judging pet peeves so that she could explain some of them and take other concerns with her to judges forums.

Overall, everyone left with valuable suggestions that will help them prepare for this year's show season. We would like to offer a big "Thank You" to Ann for donating her time and expertise!
