#### **BIOSECURITY IS EVERYONE'S BUSINESS**



In light of the recent EHV-1 (equine herpes virus) outbreak, ESDCTA wants all competitors to feel comfortable that their horse's health is of primary concern to both our organization and the HPNJ management. At this time, biosecurity measures have been developed for the ESDCTA Memorial Day Weekend show. Please check the ESDCTA website regularly for any additional updates that may be posted.

#### Some highlights:

- All occupied stalls will be disinfected between each horse show
- It is strongly recommended that all horses be vaccinated for EHV-1
- A stall chart will posted for you to document your horse's daily temperature and don't ship horses with elevated temperatures
- Use common sense: wash hands in between touching different horses, don't share equipment, don't immerse the hose end into your water bucket while filling it, avoid hand grazing

#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

It is show season and we are on the road!

That means trailer safety. There was a great, succinct article in the May 2013 issue of Horse and Rider, written by Gavin Ehringer, titled "Trailer Care." Taking CARE of your trailer means safety, literally, down the road.

Yearly maintenance is a no-brainer. Here in the upper Mid-Atlantic, we may not be using our trailer during the non-show season of winter. Just sitting all winter does not mean that no use means no problems. In fact, it could be the opposite.

Ehringer says the annual inspection and servicing should include the tires, wheels, axles, brakes and suspension. He says tires "age like milk, not fine wine." Letting your tires sit all winter subjects them to rot, cracking and delamination.

Here is a good one — your trailer coupler. Have your mechanic check for proper torque of the hitch ball and proper function of the coupling system. How many times have we heard — and sometimes been involved — in a trailer DE-hitching!?!

Don't forget your lights, Ehringer warns. Not only are malfunctioning lights dangerous, they are illegal and you could get stopped. In addition to the inconvenience and cost of a ticket, why risk having to pull over with your horses?

Exterior and Interior inspections are also a must. Ehringer said taking care of the exterior will eliminate rust and rotting. If you can, store your trailer under a roof. Even an inexpensive tarp thrown on top will help.

The interior, of course, is all about the horses. Do a structural inspection but also remove the floor mats and inspect the floor. Ehringer points out that pointy objects or sharp edges have to go!

And finally, before you hit the road, Ehringer advises to keep these tools on board:

Road maps, GPS, cell phone with charger – first aid kit – fire extinguisher – water for horses and humans – horse blankets for shock and sleeping bags for humans in cold weather – stall equipment like shovels, brooms, buckets and sponges – flashlights, duct tape, extra halters and other emergency items – nonperishable food – legal and emergency paperwork, including your out-of-state veterinary certificates.

It is a long list to think about and prepare for, but well worth it.

I wish you safe travels during this show season!

Now that we are finally enjoying spring-like weather we all are ready to venture out and go to shows, either as a competitor, a volunteer, or a spectator. Consulting our handy 2013 Omnibus, the first event coming up is the CCI3\*, 2\* and CIC3\*, 2\* Jersey Fresh. The Pro Tour of Professional Riders has added this prestigious event to their list of "go-to events" and the names of the competitors again this year reads like a "Who's Who" of the top eventing riders in America. If you want to experience a wonderful day at the Horse Park of New Jersey (a location always worth visiting) to walk the cross country courses, to enjoy a tailgate picnic on Saturday, and to see an exciting stadium jumping finale on Sunday, please set your GPS to 626 Route 524, Allentown, NJ.

And while you are at the HPNJ, come over to the Pavilion Area where the 4-H clubs, the FFA clubs, and the NJ Region Pony Clubs will all be working hard to explain what their organizations are and why they enjoy being members of these outstanding youth organizations. All three groups will be offering activities for the young, doing fund raising to help their clubs, and presenting educational topics of interest to all.

If you like to compete in the northern part of the state, you could always enter the Dressage Schooling Show, Combined Test, and Horse Trials on May 19 at Oxbow Stables in Hamburg, NJ. A full schedule of dressage classes is offered, along with Horse Trial cross country courses through Novice and the Combined Test levels are offered thru the Preliminary Level.

ESDCTA's first cross country schooling day will be offered on the Sunday of Memorial Day Weekend. ESDCTA will also be running a CDI 3\* and a CDI 1\* Y/J Dressage Show at the same time. Eventers will have the opportunity to school cross-country jumps from pre-starter to

preliminary heights. All entries will be accepted on Sunday, May 26, as post entries. Riders must have a ground person, and be wearing approved headgear, a protective vest, and have a medical armband. The fences will be in the back field and near the flag pole in the front. The front water complex and other jumps near the dressage rings will not be open for schooling.


The month of May's last show for eventers will be the Applewood Farm Dressage Show, Combined Test, and Clear Round Jumping. Check your Omnibus for more details on this show – page 143.

The New Jersey Region Pony Club will host an Open Schooling Horse Trials on Sunday June 2, 2013, at the HPNJ. This is a major fund raiser for the pony club members in NJ and the levels offered will begin at Pre-Starter (18"-20"), Starter (2' to 2'3"), Beginner Novice, Novice, and Training. This is currently the only open schooling horse trials on the calendar at the HPNJ for 2013. More info is available in the Omnibus on page 145. The NJ Region Pony Club is hosting an ICP Level I/II workshop – the Teaching of Dressage on June 11, 12 and 13 at Rainbow Ridge Equestrian Center, Flemington, NJ. This USEA Instructor Certification Program is geared towards giving eventing instructors the credentials, knowledge, and skills needed to be effective as trainers. Foaling season is in full swing. All of the planning, worrying, and praying is finally coming to fruition, with the birth of that perfect baby horse. Then the dreaming about what that horse will become begins! Below are some interesting facts about foals and foaling.

Most foals are born between April 15 and May 15.


A newborn foals legs are already 80%-90% of the length they will be when full grown.

Foals can stand within one hour after birth, and walk, trot, and run in just two hours after birth.

It can take as little as 15 minutes for a mare to give birth and as long as an hour.

Newborn foals consume 15%-25% of their body weight in milk daily in order to gain an average of 1-2 lb a day.

In the wild, foals continue to suckle until they are about one year old, but it could be longer.

# \*\*PLEASE NOTE: THERE ARE NEW HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR HORSE TO ATTEND THE FIX-A-TEST CLINICS\*\*

All horses are required to have a current Coggins Certificate (within last 12 months) and be vaccinated for Equine EHV-1 (either modified live or killed vaccine) no sooner than 7 days prior and no later than 90 days prior to the event. Please contact the event organizers for any additional health requirements that may be necessary such as documentation of a temperature chart or health certificate. PLEASE DO NOT SHIP HORSES WITH ELEVATED TEMPERATURES since this is usually an early and effective indicator of a problem.

How to enter? Obtain your FEI Rider and Horse Registration numbers and then complete the USEF National Passport application. Your horse will need the double Equine Influenza vaccinations and then you're good to go. Check out the instructional flyer on the website.




