



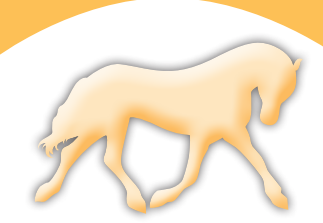

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Speaking of my mare's breeding, my fellow board member, Heidi Lemack, listened intently to my fears after the second breeding and answered my questions about the vet's protocol. I had had a breeding programs years ago, but had never used AI with the mares, only live cover. Heidi not only listened, but she offered her seasoned knowledge and continues to ask me about the mare's pregnancy each time she sees me. I appreciate that immensely. How often do we want to talk about something that means a lot to us but don't think others will be interested?

What about the barn help that didn't moan when you asked if they would give an extra flake of hay? There are so many times during the course of our routine with horses that we can remember someone with gratitude. What a wonderful surprise you can give a person this Thanksgiving by taking the time to verbally thank them for their help, or sending an email or a card with Thanksgiving wishes.

We are so busy and always on the run, without too many chances to stop and smell the roses.

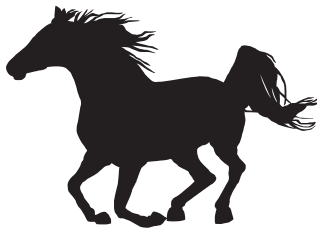

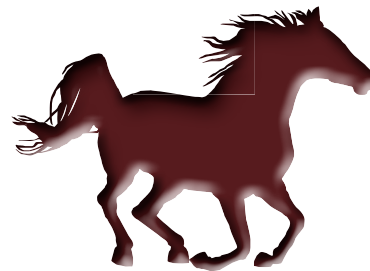

## HORSE TREATS *by Meredith Rogers*

It's the season to give thanks, which often includes giving back. Horses have been helping people since they were first domesticated, but there is a special category of horses that serve as either psychological or physical (or both) therapists for humans in need. With some forms of equine therapy, the therapist teaches the patient to work with the horse in order to learn to apply those same skills to every-day life. Horses are good for this line of work because they pick up on the emotions of the people around them, which helps patients to learn that their behavior affects others. Therapeutic horseback riding has been shown to build motor, communication, and social skills. The horse's pelvis moves similarly to a human's, providing sensory input that helps improve neurologic function and sensory processing.

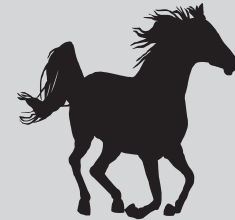

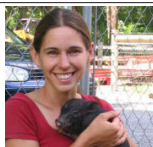
