

THE START BOX

Eventing News

Ready or not, the fall season is nearly here. If you have kids, or were ever a school kid yourself, you probably think the season coincides with the beginning of the school year – easy. So who needs to follow the calendar? You do – if you want to take advantage of the terrific riding opportunities that this time of year offers.

By now, you should have submitted your entry for the ESDCTA Eventing Championships and Open Schooling Horse Trials. Closing date was August 19, but entries will be accepted through September 8 at the discretion of the organizer and will be subject to a \$35 late fee. Set at the Horse Park of New Jersey, the event promises terrific facilities, quality jumps, and welcoming terrain.

Coming off your terrific showing at the event on September 15, you'll be set for another run for the blue at the ESDCTA NJ Horse Trials on October 5 and 6. This USEA, USEF #316845, ESDCTA-registered event offers levels from starter through preliminary. See Omnibus pages 99-100 for details. The closing date for this event is September 17. This event will also take place at the centrally located Horse Park of New Jersey. The venue is very horse and rider friendly.

ESDCTA is hosting an open Cross Country Schooling Day at the Horse Park of New Jersey on October 13. Did you have a sticky fence at one of the horse trials? This is your opportunity master it. Did the fences at the level higher than you've been showing seem inviting as you galloped past them? This schooling day is your chance to try them out with no pressure. No preregistration is required. See page 144 in the Omnibus for details.

Fall is a fabulous time to be out enjoying your horse. There are, however, a few things to keep in mind. Some horses are quick to become wooly mammoths. They may overheat or become soaked in sweat galloping cross country. Try to inhibit extreme hair growth by using sheets early in the season. If you lose that battle, consider a full or trace clip. Rinsing your horse requires a bit of planning as the temperature drops. The water you have stored in your trailer can be quite cool if the prior night was chilly. Set your filled buckets or carriers in the sun when you arrive at the event to take the edge off. Your horse will appreciate a more moderate bath, and you or your groom won't mind missing ice water splashes.

Do you remember that dressage jacket that you were excused from wearing all summer? Well you had better find it and make sure it's clean. Don't pile on layers to beat the early morning chill only to find out that you are as immobile as the little brother in The Christmas Story. Invest in a quality athletic stealthy undergarment before you head to the show. Check its fit with your jacket on. Make sure that the fuchsia or lime green does show above your stock tie.

Fall can be pressure filled for some riders. There's that sense of fear that the season is ending and not all goals may have been met. Don't fall into that trap. Unless you are a professional, your absolute priority should be enjoyment. Who cares if you haven't won at your current level or if you haven't finished with a final score under 30 or 35 or 40? Don't move up just because the number of remaining events this year is diminishing. Keep in mind that many events increase in difficulty throughout the year. It may just be that you do not be recognizing your improvements over time.

Speaking of difficulty, would you know what to do in the situation that the ESDCTA Youth training level riders faced at Millbrook this year? Mid-course there was a line consisting of a significant drop into the water, a run through the water and a table downhill from the water. This was a relatively straight line except for the fact that the novice fence out of the water was in the line. The training riders could choose to exit the water to the side, but that could cost time or fluidity. Riders were permitted to jump the novice fence because it was in their path and at a lower level. Just something to think about.



ESDCTA FALL POSITION AND SADDLE SYMPOSIUM FOR ALL DISCIPLINES



OCTOBER 4-6, 2013

Dressage Olympian Dorothy Morkis and Master Saddler David Young The Symposium will consist of a lecture Friday night featuring Dorothy Morkis (1976 Olympic Bronze Team Medalist) and her experiences throughout her life with regard to making an Olympic team, how dressage has changed over the years, and how a riders position effects the horse. David Young, Master Saddler will compliment the discussion by explaining the construction of the saddle, with visual aids such as trees and all parts of the saddle. He will explain the parts of the saddle that are for the horse and those which are for the rider and how they affect the balance in both the rider and horse. The objective of the Symposium is to provide a tool by which riders of every discipline can evaluate the components of position in order to ultimately enhance their ride.

Saturday and Sunday will be 8 Sessions rides which will start with an evaluation of the saddle on your horse and will follow with a position lesson with Dorothy Morkis.

I learned that studying for the written test is very, very important and one point on the written test could be the difference between third and first! I learned that without a wonderful four-legged partner I have nothing, so above all and before all, my pony comes first. I learned that hard work pays off.

I hope that I get the opportunity to compete at YDF again next year. It is the most fun thing that I have done so far with my pony. I am already thinking hard of how I can decorate my tack room next year! Thank you ESDCTA!



THE ESDCTA IS ENTERING THE MODERN AGE

A new age has come. The ESDCTA will offer the 2014 Omnibus in electronic form to all members. For show managers, this will have a major impact on your shows making it possible to reach more members through the ESDCTA website and updating your show information.

This will also be a benefit to our members since the prize lists will be posted to our website before the end of the year so competitors can start planning their show season earlier.

The calendar will be on the website and can be viewed in different formats, and along with the Google Maps feature, will allow competitors to find out where each show is located.

An index of shows will be e-blasted to all members once a month to keep everyone advised of all of the available shows.

Delivering the Omnibus on line has increased ESDCTA's ability to improve the information delivery to the show's target audience and competitors. The added ability to make corrections and add shows during the show season is a state-of-the-art feature, changing the Omnibus from a static document to something that evolves throughout the year and provides the competitor with the latest, up-to-date information.

I will be contacting show managers soon with all of the information for registering a show in the new electronic way, along with the 2013 show calendar and new fee structure. As always, those with set show dates will have the chance to renew, and new dates can be added, as well. Show dates need to be picked by October 15, and prize lists need to be ready for posting by November 1. These can be updated with judge, show secretary, and manager information, etc. at any time with the new electronic delivery.
