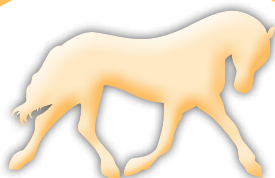

FUN, EXCITEMENT, AND AWARDS AT THE ESDCTA EVENTING CHAMPIONSHIPS!

Sunday, October 5, served up fabulous weather and fun at the ESDCTA Horse Trials at the Horse Park of New Jersey. The trials featured the ESDCTA Eventing Championships and an open team competition. A total of 143 riders entered at A at levels from starter through preliminary. They then moved onto inviting stadium and cross country courses laid out by talented designer Morgan Rowsell.

Three sand dressage rings were utilized in order to allow the ponies to strut their stuff during phase one. Competitors then moved onto the grass near the indoor arena for stadium jumping. From there, it was a short walk to the start of cross country. The course was designed to take a unique route, appropriate for a championship. Riders negotiated two jumps prior the crossing the sand path that traversed the main road entering the park. From there, they enjoyed the rolling terrain and a wide variety of obstacles. Many of the jumps were decorated with fresh mums. Others sported fall and Halloween decorations. Two water complexes were also on course. Riders were full of smiles and pride as they passed through the finish flags and competitors had nothing but good things to say about the courses.

Competitors earned eligibility for the annual championship division by having final scores of 50 penalty points or less at an ESDCTA or USEA recognized horse trial during the current competition year and being members of ESDCTA in good standing. In prior years, the eventing championships were held concurrently with the dressage championships. The dates were changed for 2014 in order to allow ESDCTA members the opportunity to compete in both championship shows. Those who pinned in the championship divisions were acknowledged with a mounted ceremony, lavish ribbons, and special prizes. Competitors were welcomed to enjoy the treats on the hospitality table that had been set up especially for the championship competitors.

This event also hosted an Adult Team Challenge for the second year in a row, which was open to adults 21 and over riding at any level. Some competitors named their teammates when they entered. Others indicated their willingness to be on a team and left it up to the event organizers to set teams. Five full teams were fielded. Riders were pinned as individuals and again as teams. USEA Area 2 provided special ribbons for the teams. Additionally for the first time at this event there was an Intercollegiate Team Challenge. To be on this team the rider could be at any level but had to be a college student at the time of the event. Unfortunately there was only 1 team entered from various NJ Colleges (Rutgers, Raritan Valley, and Monmouth)

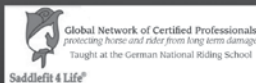

COMMUNITY NEWS

Your horse is your partner, your pet, possibly your “child,” and your responsibility. Part of this responsibility means making sure your horse is in good physical health. With all of this talk about Ebola, we sometimes forget the threats closer to home. This August and September three horses in NJ were diagnosed with Eastern equine encephalitis. A mare from Gloucester County began showing symptoms August 10 and was euthanized September 10, another mare who had been vaccinated in the spring from Ocean county died September 14, and a gelding from Burlington County was euthanized due to the disease on September 21. Cases have also been seen in several neighboring states. Although not absolute, vaccinating your horse helps to stop the spread of mosquito-spread diseases such as EEE, so make sure your horse’s shots are up to date.

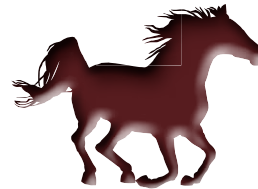

but the team was awarded with a trophy, large blue ribbon provided by ESDCTA, as well as a nice saddle pad and matching lead rope provided by A&B Tack. So hopefully next year those of you in college will tell your friends and sign up to win some of these awesome prizes!

*** BY THE NUMBERS***

Riders listed hometowns in 15 states from Florida to Texas to New Hampshire. This was quite an impressive draw. We've come up with some trivia, after reviewing the entries.

The most common breed by far was the Thoroughbred. Per the USDA, thoroughbreds make up only 10% of the US horse population and Quarter Horses make up nearly 40%. However, about 49% of the horses in the horse trials were Thoroughbreds, and 63% of the entrants were Thoroughbreds or Thoroughbred crosses. Only 1 was a Quarter Horse. Eleven Irish Sport horses, 8 Oldenburgs, 5 warmbloods, 4 Holsteiners, 4 Connemeras, 3 Trakheners and 2 Westphalians also competed. Other breeds, including Mustang, Haflinger, Appaloosa, Morgan, and Rocky Mountain were represented by 1 entrant each.

More than half, 51%, of the horses were bay, 23% were chestnut, and 14 % were grey. Other colors represented were pinto, brown, black, cremello, and palomino. The average age of the horses was just shy of 10 years. Three 4 year olds tackled the course. Mature horses were also well represented by two 17 year olds, three 18 year olds, and one each 19 and 20 year old. The mean age of the horses in the starter division was a bit more than 2 years older than the mean age in the other divisions. Packers clearly have a role in taking care of the starter riders!

The height of the horses ranged from a compact 13.1 hh to a very significant 18.2 hh. It is difficult to determine if this is a trend that is seen across the sport at other events, but the average size at the ESDCTA horse trials decreased through the divisions. Preliminary horses averaged 16.1 hh, while starter horses sported an average height of 15.2 hh. Only 31% of the equines were mares. Was this a fluke, or perhaps a representation of prejudice against the gender? Hopefully, the girls will be out in bigger numbers next year.

The ESDCTA Eventing Committee received 20 event reviews soon after the conclusion of the event. All reported that they considered the event to have been well run and enjoyable. Some of the reviews included suggestions for next year. These thoughts will be given full consideration as the committee plans for 2015. President - Lisa Toaldo

Dr. Lisa Toaldo, an equestrian competitor, show manager, USEF Technical Delegate Apprentice, PM Delegate GMO Delegate and ESDCTA President has been involved with dressage in many capacities. As an avid supporter of education, she has run several programs and has been involved in numerous others, including the USDF L program and USEF S program. She has served as a GMO Vice President, Marketing Chair, and President, most recently.

As ESDCTA President this past year she has worked to re-organize and strengthen the club by gathering a cohesive team on the Board, which has served to bring the club forward with new technology. The club has, under her direction, gathered 22 business members, more than 500 members, and for the first time in several years won the spot for the BLM Championships to be hosted by the club. The club also has returned to its mission of education by presenting an educational event with Anne Gribbons, something that has not been done in several years.

Present at all of the events, shows, and by direct contact with members past and present, Lisa has demonstrated her special direct and welcoming leadership style that has brought many members back to the club. She is a very visible and involved president.

Her future plan and wishes for the club are as follows:

Vice President - Heidi Lemack

I am an owner/trainer at Rhythm and Blues Stables, Allentown, NJ, a USDF bronze medalist, silver medalist, and an "L" graduate. I have been a member and volunteer with the ESDCTA since moving to NJ 15 years ago, and joined the board 4 years ago as a Youth Co-Chair. This past year I served as Vice President.

I envision the ESDCTA as serving all aspects of the local dressage and eventing communities: adult amateurs, local Olympic hopefuls, youth, and all those new to dressage and eventing. For all of these individuals, the ESDCTA needs to be welcoming and provide educational and competition opportunities.

Secretary - Beth Ann Adams

I have served on the Executive Board as Secretary for 5 years, taking over for Cindy Anderson while Tara Bowls was President, Susan Lax replaced her and now Lisa Toaldo is President. During all of those years, I've witnessed ESDCTA evolve into a GMO with much influence in the local equestrian community. Our Board has experienced growing pains in the past and the present. I served as a Day Liaison at the ESDCTA Memorial Day show- both to competitors and Member recruitment. I am working to provide a ride-critique- ride service to the Eventing Committee and ESDCTA membership. I will continue to participate, volunteer, and support thoughtful change and growth of the club and their offerings.

I relocated to Hunterdon County, NJ, in February 2012. Prior to that, I was a resident of Southeastern CT, for 17 years. During that time I owned 2 private farms. I was an adult amateur for the majority of that time, working in the pharmaceutical industry by day and taking care of farm and horses on "both the other ends of the candle". Until 2001, I competed in rated eventing through Training Level and lower level dressage (Training/First). HORSE TREATS *by Meredith Rogers*

Veterans Day (Nov 11, 2014) is a day of remembrance for those who have served in the US Armed Forces. As a point of clarification, Memorial Day was established to honor those men and women who died in the service of our country as part of the US Armed Forces. We should not forget that numerous horses have fought and died in wars, and below is the story of one such honoree.

Sgt Reckless was a mare so heroic during the Korean War that she was promoted to Staff Sergeant by the Commandant of the US Marine Corps. She received two Purple Hearts, a Good Conduct Medal, a Presidential Unit Citation with star, a National Defense Service Medal, a Korean Service Medal, a United Nations Service Medal, a Navy Unit Commendation, and a Republic of Korea Presidential Unit Citation.

She was originally purchased by Lt Eric Pedersen for \$250 of his own money from a Korean boy, who needed the money to pay for an artificial leg for his sister. Reckless' job was to carry ammunition to the front lines. One of her most heroic feats was crossing the deadly "no man's land" rice paddies and then up a steep 45-deg mountain trail to the firing site of waiting marines during a particularly fierce battle, with enemy fire coming in at the rate of 500 rounds per minute. She carried injured men back down the mountain, before being loaded back up with ammunition to do it all again. She did this trip 51 times in one day alone, carrying 386 rounds of ammunition (almost 5 tons worth), walking more than 35 miles, and 95% of the time she made the trip on her own! She also served as a shield for several marines who were trapped, and was wounded twice but kept going.

The Marines were not only endeared to her because of her bravery but also because of her playful personality. She was known to eat everything and anything in sight. She loved scrambled eggs and pancakes along with her morning coffee, but was also known to eat poker chips, blankets, and hats if she thought she was being ignored.

Reckless was retired in 1960 to Camp Pendleton, and died in 1968. She was buried with full military honors at Camp Pendleton.
