ESDCTA YOUTH PARTICIPATE AT YDF

Fun, Learning, and Camaraderie at Lendon Gray's Youth Dressage Festival

On the second weekend of July, over 300 riders, comprising more than 60 teams of riders, competed in a three-day dressage and academic competition at Lendon Gray's Youth Dressage Festival.

Thursday and Friday were the "moving-in" days for the horses and the riders. After carting armfuls of tack, feed, buckets, brushes, hay, shavings, and maybe a couple things for the riders, team ESDCTA was successfully moved in. The weekend started with a written test based on two books that each age group of riders was required to read. The biggest challenge of the weekend was to make sure that our tests did not get blown away or soaked in the rain (the only imperfect weather we had all weekend). After the written test, we decorated our tack room and the whole stable area, transforming it into an amusement park complete with a roller-coaster (downsized), a tramcar, go-carts, games, prizes, merry-go-round horses, and balloons. This tack room tied us for the win in the coveted Tack Room Decorating Competition for the most elaborate tack room. After all the horses were fed and watered, and the tack room was decorated, team ESDCTA moved on to the hotel to swim, have a pizza party, and have some team bonding time.

Saturday was the day that everyone looks forward to: the actual riding competition. We were all to compete in a dressage equitation class and a dressage test. The show grounds were already in full swing by 5:30 in the morning. Horses needed to be braided, hand-walked, groomed, and fed, as well as needing their stalls cleaned. Saturday proved to be a challenge for me and my horse. Going from being turned out 24/7 to being in a stall all day and night caused my 7-year-old mare to have excess energy, which did not combine well with the crowded warm-up ring. But, we worked through it and had a very nice equitation class and first level dressage test. One thing I loved about this show was that everything was right on time. Also, it was educational and fun to watch other riders compete from intro, to FEI pony level, to forth level dressage. Supporting your team was an important factor in this competition. If I was not riding, taking care of my horse, or volunteering, I was cheering at the dressage tests of my teammates.

Saturday night consisted of the parade of breeds and the parade of teams. The parade of breeds showcased about 15 different horse breeds and facts about all of them. It was interesting to see all of the different breeds that were at the festival and how all of them could compete at the higher levels. The parade of teams was when our team came into play. Every team entered the arena and got awards based on overall scores of the competition and also the tack room competition. Preceding the very nice awards ceremony, at which Lendon and the judges spoke, was a pizza party for all of the competitors. One of the best parts of the whole weekend was being able to have ample time to socialize and meet new people who all share our love of horses. Being sponsored by the ESDCTA to compete in the weekend placed me on a team of people, most of whom I have never met but grew to love in only two days! I feel that we all met friends who we are going to keep for a long time.

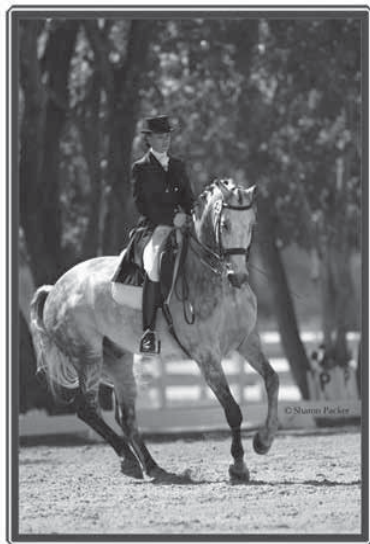

2011 ESDCTA CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

QUALIFYING INFORMATION

Show season is hitting mid-stride but it's not too early to start thinking about the 2011 ESDCTA Championship Show. The date is September 18, 2011, at the Horse Park of New Jersey. Many of you have already qualified to ride in the show; for those of you who haven't yet qualified, there is still time. The qualifying period started on August 23, 2010, and will end August 22, 2011. Postcards will be sent to qualifying riders in the next couple of weeks.

You qualify to ride based on scores earned at ESDCTA-sanctioned schooling and recognized shows. You need only one score to qualify as follows:

Starter – W/T: USDF – A or USDF – B - One ride of 60% or higher

Starter – W/T/C: USDF – C or Training – 1 – One ride of 60% or higher

Training through Second Levels: Test 2 or 3 – One ride of 60% or higher

Third and Fourth Levels: Test 2 or 3 – One ride of 58% or higher

FEI Levels – One score of 58% or higher

Musical Freestyle – All Levels – One ride of 60% or higher

Although you only need one score to qualify to ride in the show, at the show, you will be riding the top *two* tests of the level, as follows:

Starter – W/T: USDF – A and USDF – B **Starter W/T/C:** USDF – C and Training – 1

Training through Fourth Levels: Tests 2 and 3 of the level

FEI and Musical Freestyle: One ride at the qualifying level

The same qualifying horse and rider combination must be paired at the show. If you qualified with the same horse in more than one division, *you must choose only one division*; you cannot ride four tests. All riders who qualified to ride in the show have automatically qualified to ride in Dressage Seat Equitation. Scores earned at the ESDCTA Championship Show can be used towards ESDCTA Year-End Awards – review the Year-End Award in the *Omnibus* beginning on Page 39.

The Starter Division is for riders, Junior or Senior, who have never ridden above 2011 Training Level, Test 1. If you were a Starter rider in 2010 and have not ridden over Training Level, Test 1, in 2011, you are still considered a Starter rider. The day you ride 2011 Training Level, Test 2 or higher, you are no longer considered a Starter Rider and cannot participate in the Starter Division at the championship show. Qualifying is based on Starter Rider, *not Starter Horse*. Refer to the Year-End Award criteria for a further explanation of Starter Rider.

Qualifiers are listed on the ESDCTA website (www.esdcta.or). If you think you've qualified but don't see your name on the list, please contact me so I can verify your qualifying ride. Opening day for entries is July 30, and the closing date is August 22. I may not be able to get the list up-dated in time so you can attach a copy of your qualifying test to your show entry.

Refer to Page 22 in the *Omnibus* for general show information. Pages 141-142 have the prize list and entry information. Show entry forms are available on the website.

Take a few minutes now to look at the information so you can have any questions addressed. Don't miss out on an opportunity to participate in this great show!

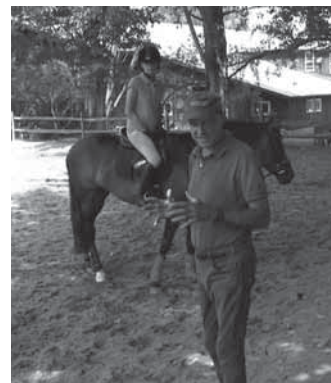

A Connoisseur of Camps

Thanks to educational grants from ESDCTA, I have been fortunate to attend two different adult riding camps in Vermont. Several friends have asked how I chose them and how they compare. When I initially began thinking about going to a camp with my horse—something I had never done because I never had a horse until five years ago—I first read reports from riders who had attended various camps: the USEA camps in North Carolina and Vermont, Denny Emerson's camps in the same states, Philip Dutton's camp in Pennsylvania, and Karen and David O'Connor's camp in Virginia. I had attended a two-day clinic with Lucinda Greene, and I had specific aspects of my riding that I wanted to improve. The reports helped me to assess each camp's program in relation to my goals and to get some idea of the riding levels of the campers at each.

In the end, however, it was the chance to watch and help ESDCTA riders at the Green Mountain Horse Association (GMHA) Training/Novice 3-Day Event in August 2010 that led me to choose Denny Emerson's camp, which ran in the week after the event. Denny runs a very structured camp. He's a teacher, and he expects you to show up not only for your morning and afternoon lessons (dressage with Sue Berrill and jumping with Sue and Denny), but also for the discussions and demonstrations following lunch and dinner. If you've read Denny's columns over the years (and now his new book, *How Good Riders Get Good*), you already know the kinds of skills he emphasizes—feeling the correct canter, developing an eye for striding, etc.—but there's nothing like having an eventing legend focused on *your* canter and *your* eye, and his Jack Le Goff impersonations were priceless. I came away just as Denny intended, a more confident rider with more “arrows in my quiver.”

Having watched my friends have a blast at GMHA last year, I set my sights on riding in the Novice 3-Day this year. To get my horse and me acclimated to the grounds and the terrain, I decided to attend the USEA Adult Education Seminar held at GMHA. The camp follows immediately upon the June horse trials there, so the cross-country and stadium jumps are still up and flagged. What a contrast! At first, I was somewhat anxious about the seemingly casual approach to scheduling by the camp's founder and organizer, Barbara Marks of Southern Pines, NC. But I was immediately won over by her enthusiasm and by the extraordinary generosity of the clinicians. Barbara has been doing this for more than twenty years, and she knows how to persuade the best teachers to come to her camp year after year. The upper-level dressage riders had coaching from Holger Bechtloff, James Koford, Diane Ritz, and John Zapotti, all of who gave just as much serious attention to the greenest of event horses and riders as to the seasoned pros. Jumping was expertly and encouragingly supervised by Robert Costello, Jane Hamlin, Marcia Kulak, and Michael Page.

Forget the schedule! If a rider felt s/he should be in a different jumping group or wanted to try a lesson with a different clinician, every effort was made to accommodate the request. All that juggling made for very busy days for the clinicians, and we never did have the promised lunchtime talks. We made up for that with evening cocktails on the expansive porch of the GMHA Youth Center. (All meals are included, by the way, and were delicious!)

So, why make the large financial and time investment to go to a camp? More than a one- or two-day clinic near home, the camps gave me a chance to get outside of my everyday riding routines and to spend time with my horse in a way not usually possible. Under the eyes of trainers who had never seen me and my horse, I had to make an honest assessment of our weaknesses (mostly mine—stress on honest!). To be sure, no quick fixes were promised, but in each case I've come home with a plan for improvement and the confidence that I can be a better camper next year.

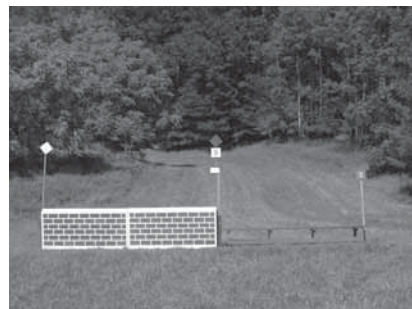
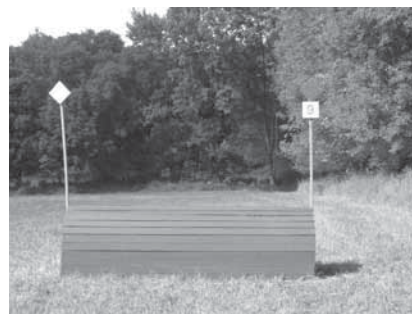
