## Happy Thanksgiving!

### Championships – A Not-To-Be-Missed Event

This year's ESDCTA Championships were a resounding success. The show grounds at the Horse Park of New Jersey looked gorgeous, and the setting was graced with picture-perfect weather.

For the first time, the ESDCTA combined the Dressage and Eventing Championships into one show. According to Beth Ann Adams, the show's Secretary (and ESDCTA Recording Secretary), "... combining the two events added new things for spectators to see and gave both show committees a chance to observe and learn from each other." From the perspective of a spectator and competitor, I couldn't agree more. I enjoyed the presence of the eventers; seeing them navigating the courses enhanced the atmosphere. As we shared the same space and had occasion to "rub elbows" I sensed a spirit of mutual support, common purpose, and camaraderie among all the participants. No matter what level we were riding at, the Championships represented an achievement, a culmination of efforts for the season.

Thanks to the hard work of the show's organizers and all of the others involved (including sponsors and vendors); everything ran smoothly. In particular, the volunteers not only worked hard, but contributed to the positive and supportive environment of the show. Without their help, the event could not have been the success that it was. Stacey Kimmel-Smith was one of those volunteers. "I was at the ESDCTA championships as a volunteer scorer. Scoring may sound dull but at the Horse Park it's far from it. During the 'downtime' you have a great view of the action and folks to chat with. There was such a diversity of horses in the competition – several paints with unusual markings, a friesian-draft cross, a number of ponies – all performing beautifully. It was fun and inspiring."

Indeed there was much to see at the show, and many levels of riding to observe. There was activity in every ring and throughout the grounds. I enjoyed watching everything, from the riders preparing in the warm-up ring to the beautiful musical freestyles.

Dressage Seat Equitation was a new class for me to compete in, and it was both fun and informative. The class featured general remarks from the judge (including some new USDF directives), as well as individual feedback for each rider.

As a fairly new ESDCTA member, this was my first time attending and competing in the Dressage Championship Show. I wasn't alone in that respect. There were a record number of "newbies" (competitors riding for the first time at Championships) this year. The 2012 Championships also had a record number of youths competing.

I hope that some of this year's new Championship Show competitors will not only participate in the show next year, but also discover additional opportunities for involvement with ESDCTA.

The chance to qualify for and compete in the Championship is just one of the many benefits of ESDCTA membership. Among the numerous ESDCTA events are several educational activities, including the ESDCTA-sponsored clinics, seminars, and webinars. As an educator (college professor) I'm drawn to ESDCTA because of all of the learning opportunities it offers. We're in a region rich with equestrian knowledge and talent, and ESDCTA is a great conduit to access that.

One way that ESDCTA fulfills its educational mission is through the Educational Grants program. As the new Chair of the Educational Grants Committee I'm proud to be part of this process and encourage members to learn more about these grants and consider applying for one. Here's to your participation in 2013!

Not Gary. He is just plain nice. No matter what task he is doing or with whom he is doing it, he is nice.

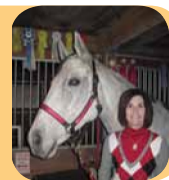

**DIRECTIONS FROM FLEMINGTON CIRCLE:**

South on Route 202/31 South. About 3.5 miles from the circle, you will pass Stewart's Root Beer on the right hand side. Copper Hill Road is the second right past Stewart's. Before the traffic light, you will see a sign "Copper Hill Road Keep Right". Veer off onto the jug handle, turn right at the yield sign and follow down the hill. You will see the Clubhouse on your right hand side. To get to the parking lot, go half way around the circle and turn right at the stop sign.

**From South Jersey:** - Routes 295, 195, or 95 to Route 31 North. Stay on 31 North until it joins with 202 North. Exit onto 202/31 North. Follow approximately 3 miles to light at Copper Hill Road. Take jug-handle on right. Cross 202/31 North onto Copper Hill Road. Follow road up to Clubhouse at top of hill on right.

**From North Jersey:** - Route 80 East or West to Route 287 South to the Somerville Circle. Follow signs for Route 202 South to Flemington. At the Flemington 202/31 Circle continue halfway around onto Route 202 South. Proceed approximately 3 miles through the traffic light at Stewart's Root Beer. Turn right just before the next light onto Copper-Hill Road. Follow road up to Clubhouse at top of hill on right.

### **Two Scholarship Opportunities**

New Jersey residents who are entering their senior year in high school this fall and are planning a career in agriculture or science may apply for the New Jersey Agricultural Achievement Award. The New Jersey Agricultural Achievement Award, sponsored by Amy Butewicz, a former New Jersey Equestrian of the Year, was started because of her desire to give back to the community. Worth \$500, this scholarship is meant to assist its recipient in beginning their future in agriculture. Named the Sara Dubinin Scholarship, in memory of Sara Dubinin, who loved horses, it will be presented at the New Jersey Bred Equine Breeder Awards Luncheon on January 27, 2013, At Charley's Other Brother Restaurant in Eastampton. Sara, a Sayreville resident, graduated from Cardinal McCarrick High School in South Amboy in 2006. The 19-year-old was attending Middlesex County College when she succumbed to injuries suffered in a motor vehicle accident in September of 2007. ## CENTERLINE Dressage News

### Heads up all show organizers and competitors, There are four new USDF and USEF tests approved for the 2013 competition year

There are four new tests now available for you to add to your prize lists for the upcoming competition year.

USDF has added a Training Level Freestyle test for you to add to your musical freestyle (MFS) class offerings. The test is available at [www.usdf.org](http://www.usdf.org) along with all of the other USDF freestyle tests, and has the same qualifying criteria of all MFS classes.

As of Sept 24, 2012, the USEF has approved three Rider Tests: one test each at Training, First, and Second Levels.

The USEF explanation of the tests is as follows:  
*Issued by the USEF Dressage Department 24 September 2012*

*New 'Rider Tests' to Become Effective December 1, 2012 (2013 Competition Year)*

The United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) is pleased to announce the new Dressage Rider Tests Program for the 2013 competition year. Designed and drafted by a joint working group from the USEF Dressage Committee joined and by appointees from the United States Dressage Federation (USDF), these tests are available for use by riders at Training, First, and Second Levels. While these tests nor their subsequent scores are a requirement to progress through the levels, they are intended to help riders measure their progress.

The new tests are designed to evaluate the proficiency of the rider relative to the requirements of the given level, without giving extra credit for the horse's gaits, impulsion and submission. Riders will receive constructive evaluations that they can put to use in improving their abilities as a rider. The principles of correct application of the aids, correct riding biomechanics and the accurate geometry of the figures are assessed through 5 scores evaluating rider's position, correct and effective use of aids, horse's response and performance, accuracy of the exercises and harmony between rider and horse plus written commentary.

#### ***USEF Training Level Rider Test***

The purpose of the rider test at Training Level is to ensure that the rider has mastered the fundamentals of riding. The test states its purpose as to confirm that the rider sits in the

correct posture and alignment and shows correct mechanics in walk, rising trot and canter. The seat is sufficiently independent for the rider to maintain a steady, elastic rein contact and encourage the horse to stretch into that contact. The horse is ridden actively forward showing impulsion and balance required for the level, bends equally to the left and right sides on turns and circles, and makes smooth, willing transitions.

#### ***USEF First Level Rider Test***

In the First Level test riders are asked to continue to demonstrate the requirements of the Training Level in addition to showing increased balance and effectiveness of aids while performing more intricate movements. The test states its purpose as to confirm that the rider, in addition to the requirements of training level, shows correct alignment, posture and mechanics in sitting trot, including maintaining a steady, elastic rein contact. In turns on forehand and leg yields the rider remains centered and the horse responds willingly to the aids. The transitions are ridden in a better balance and with more throughness than at training level. In response to the correct application of the rider's aids, the horse moves actively forward showing a consistent tempo and correct rhythm in each gait, shows appropriate bending, lengthens and shortens the stride in trot and canter and responds willingly to both longitudinal and lateral aids.

#### ***USEF Second Level Rider Test***

The aim of the rider test at Second Level is that the rider can demonstrate consistency in all gaits and lateral work while showing enhanced skill from First Level. The test states its purpose as to confirm that the rider, having achieved the requirements of first level, is able to ride the horse reliably on the bit with an uphill tendency. The rider lengthens and shortens the horse's stride in trot and canter while maintaining correct alignment, posture and mechanics. In lateral movements the rider stays centered and demonstrates an appropriate angle and bending of the horse. As a result of the correct application of the rider's aids, the horse shows a greater degree of straightness, bending, suppleness, throughness, balance and self-carriage than at first level.

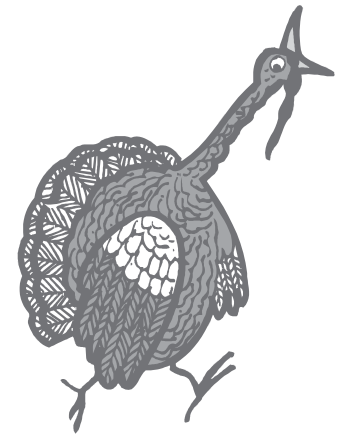

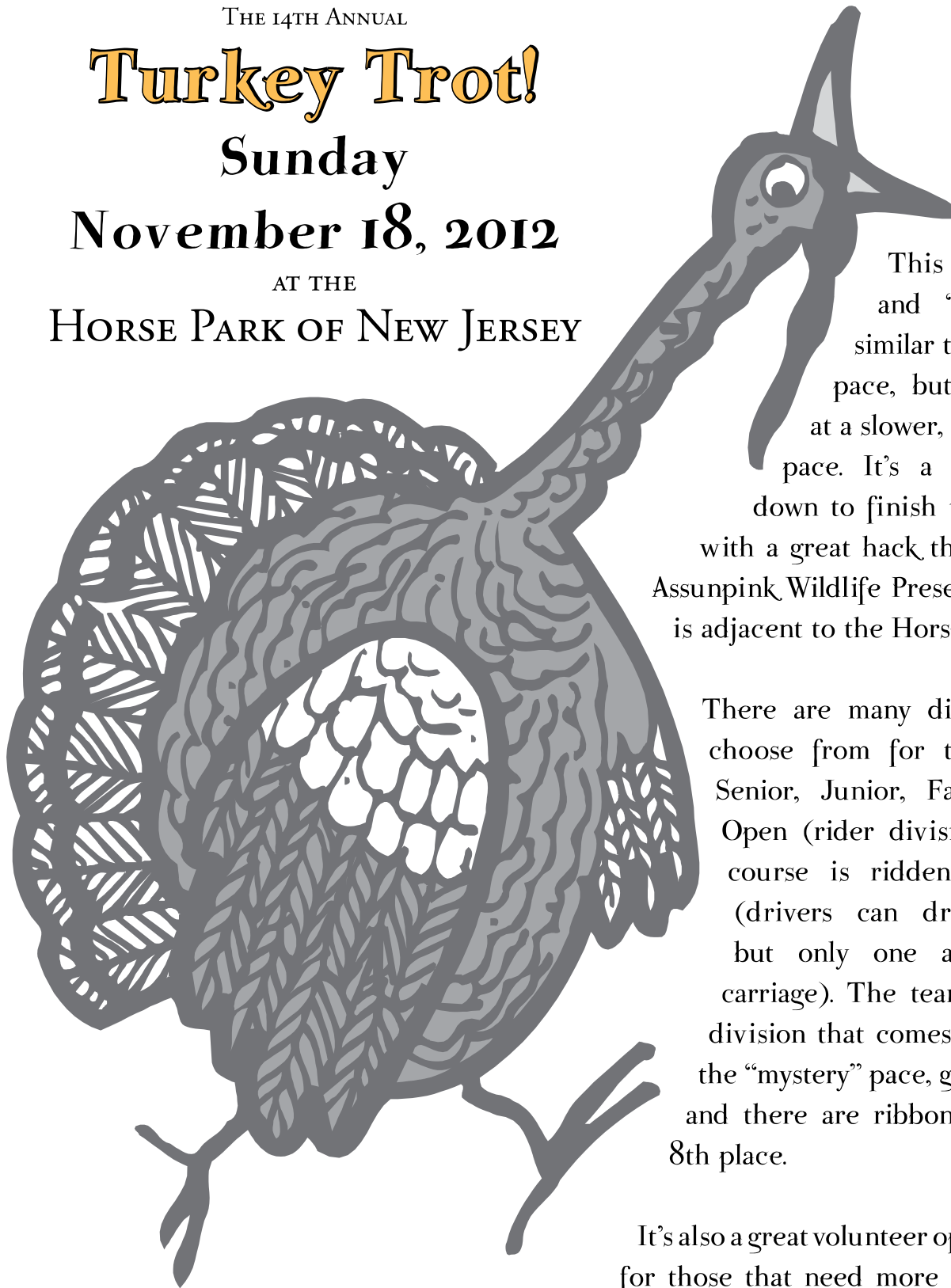

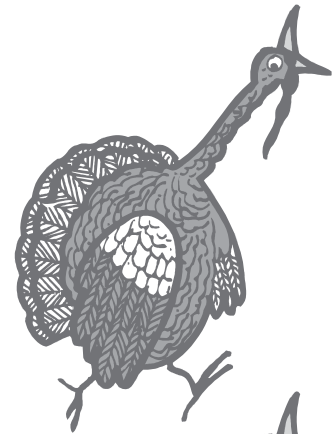
