HAVING FUN WITH YOUR HORSE AGAIN

ESDCTA/Skylands Seminar Series Continues

It was mainly about the body of horse and rider in August when Steiner Dressage demonstrated ways to condition our mind and body and Wendy Leich-Furlong explained the amazing powers of acupuncture and alternative medicinal therapies to help our horse's physical ills.

"Think of yourself as an athlete and your horse as an equal partner and athlete," Betsy Steiner told the audience at the second leg of the ESDCTA/Skylands Saddlery Summer Seminar Series.

Team Steiner – Betsy and Jessie Steiner, Assistant Trainer Sarah Travis, Intern Alyssa Gulianelli, and Intern Lucca Ruckhold – gave a bodies-on presentation. Betsy explained the goals of her Equilates as described in her book, "A Gymnastic Riding System Using Mind, Body, & Spirit." Equipped with a variety of exercise equipment, the team demonstrated techniques to relax before a ride and exercises to condition you to be the athlete necessary to accomplish your Dressage goals. Betsy said that increasing core strength not only helps you to ride better, but assists the horse when you are riding it.

"When you think about what we ask our horses to do and what we demand of them, we have to ask the same of ourselves." Betsy said. "Being able to ride the 20-meter circle without suddenly asking where did it go requires the discipline and core strength of your own body to keep everything in alignment with the horse."

Betsy also advised that the rider should not practice the "no pain, no gain," method. She said riders should learn how to really use themselves to work through their exercises for success. Steiner's Equilates is specifically Pilates for the rider. She recommended that riders tell their regular Pilates instructors exactly what they need for riding, so the instructor can adjust the exercises and program accordingly.

"Not only are these exercises great for us as athletes," Betsy said, "but you really get to see what we are asking our horses."

Just a couple of weeks later, Dr. Wendy Leich-Furlong told us that our horses have to feel good to perform well. Her informative talk answered some of the questions everyone has about alternative therapies. First and foremost, the jury was in: they work!

After using the traditional methods to help their horses, Olympic riders have come off very successful competitions to tell Wendy that their horses have never felt better. One of the added benefits for competition, Wendy said, is that dry needle acupuncture can give a competitive edge without having any issues with drug testing. An Eventer and a veterinarian, Wendy said she uses acupuncture on her own horses and achieves wonderful results, as well.

Herself a successful patient of acupuncture, Wendy said she doesn't rule out traditional medicine if needed. She said acupuncture is considered both an art and a science and, while its successes have been well documented in the field of medicine, scientists "still don't understand on a cellular basis how it works."

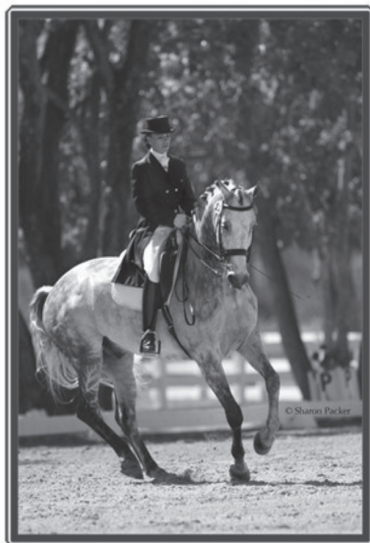
I wish you all a record-setting ride for your personal best!

ESDCTA Statement of Purpose

Wendy said learning about acupuncture has been like learning a new language. The five elements of acupuncture, for instance, are wood, fire, earth, water, and metal. Each of these elements, in turn, refers to different areas of the body. She said it is about the balance between the Chinese theory of "Yin and Yang," which are polar opposites. When the "qi" – the force and energy that controls circulation in the body – becomes blocked, the needles unblock the circulation and relieve what is termed "stagnation". She said if she succeeds in relieving the stagnation, blood, which has its own distinct black color, will often drain from the site.

After checking the "meridian" of the horse to get a diagnosis, Wendy said she can tell the owner how the horse is moving without ever watching it go. She said owners are surprised that she knows what is happening when they ride.

But no medicine is as helpful to the horse as "treating them like horses again," Wendy said, pointing out that horses were "designed to graze 20 hours a day, yet we put them in 12x12 stalls, give them two meals, and ride them hard for an hour." Instead, her prescription for success is "good turnout, adequate diet, having hay in front of them all day, minimal grains, and cross training."

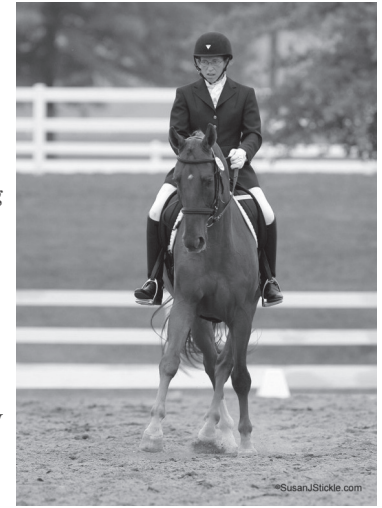
ESDCTA Trainers ' Tips, Advice, and Observations

Losing and Finding Your Confidence

I don't know how or why it happens, but at some point in most riders' lives there comes a time that we lose confidence. Here are three different scenarios that you may relate to if you find yourself lacking in the confidence department. The first scenario occurs when you believe that you can ruin your horse, even if you have a gentle snaffle, a plain pair of riding boots, and a basically reasonable temperament. The second scenario relates to "ahem" aging and the realization you are not invincible anymore. The last happens when you have been part of a traumatic incident. All three require similar paths to regaining confidence.

For the first scenario, there is no dressage god that is going to strike you down if you experiment with new ideas and play with your horse! I am still here to prove that. I strongly believe a rider becomes a horseperson by making mistakes: taking risks, having the risks not work and learning from them. Some famous person said when asked about losing many yacht races and finally winning one—and I can only paraphrase—"I never lost... I was learning to win." We have to make mistakes on our journey to becoming accomplished horse people, and be very thankful that horses are forgiving creatures. I will use myself for the second scenario; I lost confidence when I turned 39. Did I have a nasty fall? No, although I had fallen many times by then (okay-probably hundreds, but I practiced in the snow drifts as a teenager, so I got really good at it). I was not scared of falling. I asked a wonderful horse to trot—she did—I posted one stride and herniated a disc. And there it was... I was no longer invincible. Before that day, I had no fear or hesitation on the back of a horse. I would ride any horse, anywhere, under any circumstances. I had confidence and a lot of it. I used to say a bomb could go off and my horses would not notice. After the disc incident, I did physical therapy but after I got back on a horse, I found myself being very protective of my body and I started riding in the "safe zone." And my big moving horses became small moving horses, and they noticed things they had never noticed before. I lost my confidence and they lost theirs! At that point I realized I needed to not feel so vulnerable, like I could break at any time, so I went about getting stronger in my core to support my low back. With the help of a wonderful Pilates trainer, Sharon Spaziani, I came back straighter and more flexible than ever before. Thankfully, my horses returned to their original confident selves once I knew I was not as fragile as my brain and body thought. So, if you find yourself where I was, you can still ride the "10" movers, just take the time, especially off the horse, to get fitter and more flexible to prevent silly time consuming injuries like mine. Your horses will appreciate it. .



The loss of confidence due to a traumatic experience can be the most difficult to overcome. This can take a long time, but you would be amazed (or maybe not) at the number of people that I work with who want to ride when they are terrified of the "what ifs" What if the horse bucks, what if the horse spins, what if the tractor comes by, what if the snow falls off the roof, what if? Well, you get where I am going. If this this is your situation, you need to treat yourself kindly; you must accept the fact that your brain and body want you to see another day, and they both want to protect you at all costs. They are in control; you are not. So, when you ask your horse to go, your hands may be pulling back without you being aware, and when you canter, your legs may be holding so tight that you're pinching yourself out of the saddle, your horse may not be able to breath, and I can bet you're not breathing either. I am sorry to say in many cases "mind over matter" just doesn't work. (I think "love horses" and "tough minded" are on the same gene). To begin, you need to establish where your fear resides. What are the triggers that elicit fear responses in your brain and body? Once these triggers are identified, enlist the help of a safe horse and place yourself in a safe situation (this may be under the supervision of a professional). Teach your body the correct responses to adverse situations at times when the correct responses are not necessary. Such as "sit back, ride forward," or "sit back, feet forward, pull back" or the one rein stop; any survival skills you may need when a horse acts like an undomesticated beast. Also, indulge yourself with lunge lessons to develop a good, following seat. so you can follow the undomesticated beast when he spins or leaps.

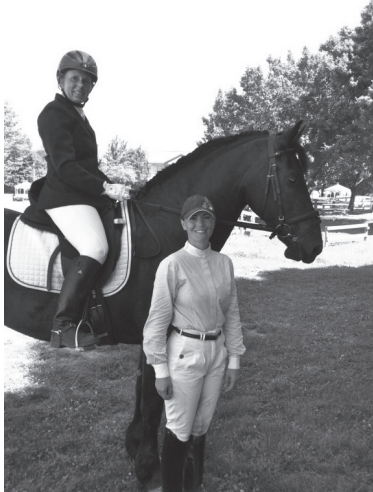
Practice your new skills during a more challenging situation, one that makes you a little uncomfortable, and test yourself and your horse's new trained responses. Gain confidence in yourself and your horse's responses. Set yourself up for success by gradually expanding your boundaries. Get out of the arena, but have a safe horse and confident supportive rider with you or someone on the ground. You will find many supportive horse people in our area and likely in your own barn if you ask—rider's love to help people get confident again. And contrary to popular belief, it is OK to get off your horse and walk them by the scary object a few times, and then get back on and ride past it. They really won't know you didn't plan to get off, and you got them by it safely after with you on their back. You may also watch another person ride the horse. Seeing someone else do what you want to do on the horse will give you a clear picture of how you need to ride, and that the horse will respond in an appropriate manner—very good for confidence boosting—and again, having someone do it for you does not make you a wimp, it makes you smart—your brain needs to see it.

ESDCTA's New Jersey Horse Trials October 29-30, 2011, at HPNJ

Opening date for entries is September 13. This USEA/USEF recognized Horse Trials will offer levels from Preliminary down to Starter. The Starter level is a non-recognized level. We urge our members to enter early, as other Horse Trials at the HPNJ this year have been well attended, many with waiting lists. See pages 102 and 103 in the 2011 Omnibus for more information.

ESDCTA's Eventing Championships Are Also Happening at Our ESDCTA New Jersey Horse Trials

Our third ESDCTA Horse Trial Championships will also be held during the New Jersey Horse Trials on October 29-30. This championship is only open to ESDCTA members who have earned a qualifying score during the qualifying period of October 1, 2010 thru October 12, 2011. Membership in ESDCTA is required at the time the score was earned. The levels included in this championship are Starter thru Preliminary.

Qualifying scores may be earned at any ESDCTA registered USEA or schooling event/horse trials or a recognized USEA event. These scores must be earned as a horse/rider combination. It is not required that the horse/rider combination achieve a certain placing, only that a maximum final penalty score of 50.0 or lower at the qualifying level be achieved.

A horse/rider combination may compete at only one level in the championships. No whips are allowed in the dressage ring if you are competing as a championship entry. Also, you must ride your dressage test from memory. Please include both a USEA entry form for your HT entry and attach an ESDCTA entry form to show you are also entering the ESDCTA HT Championships.

First Ever Eventing Challenge Open to Riders Who Compete in Horse Trials at the HPNJ

As we begin the month of August, it is sad to realize that the summer of 2011 is half gone. This means that 3 of the 5 Horse Trials that are a part of this inaugural Eventing Challenge series are completed, scored, pinned, and now history. Lastly, be honest with yourself and ask for a professional opinion about the horse you were riding when the traumatic experience happened. It may have just been a one time thing with the horse, or it could be a symptom of something wrong, either physically with the horse or with your relationship with the horse. Remember riding is challenging enough, and we are supposed to enjoy it. If the horse is not a good match for your time schedule, riding skill set, comfort zone or whatever, it does not mean you or the horse are a failure. Think of it as a marriage between two good people that just don't get along—it's no good for either one and both will be happier and better off apart. Do get professional help in assessing the horse and the situation. Reestablishing confidence involves being honest with yourself. You need to dig deep and find the source causing your lack of confidence. Once you have figured that out, make a plan, find the people to support you, be ready for setbacks, and remember you were born with the "horseperson gene."

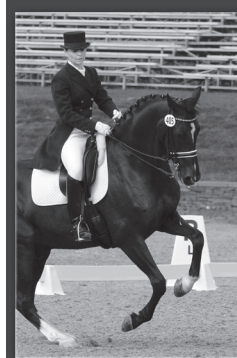



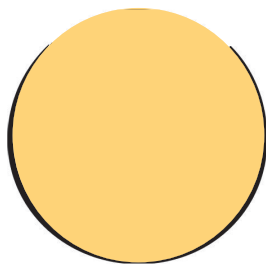
